The word gospel means "GOOD NEWS."

Before I ask you what the GOOD NEWS is, I want you to tell me what the bad news of the Bible is.

The bad news of the Bible is?

Isa 59:1 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:

Isa 59:2 But your iniquities have separated 5. _____, and your sins have hid *his* face from you, that he will not hear.

Rom 3:23 For 6. _____, and come short of the glory of God;

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin *is* 7. _____; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Sin separates us from God.

We have all sinned.

The wages of sin is death.

That is really bad news.

The GOOD NEWS must be something that will keep us from having to face the really bad news of sin and death.

If you were supposed to die tomorrow for a crime you had committed, then what would be good news to you today.

A million dollars? A new car?

The only thing that could be good news today would be to hear that you no longer have to die.

We have that GOOD NEWS in Christ who died in our place on the cross.

Being in sin we could not be the atoning sacrifice for our own sins.

But, in Christ, though we will face physical death, we will no longer have to face a spiritual death.

What is the GOOD NEWS that saves us from the bad news about sin and death?

and to **come unto the knowledge of the truth**.

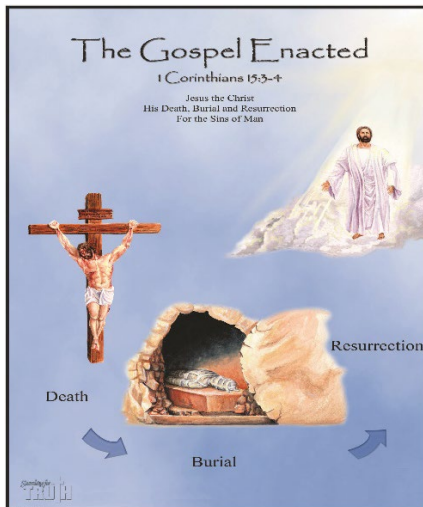
